

***ARTICLE V. MUNICIPAL YACHT HARBOR<sup>1</sup>***

**Sec. 170-644. Trespass at public boat launch.**

- (a) Trespass upon the premises of the New Orleans Public Boat Launch is the intentional, unauthorized entry upon the premises of the public boat launch or remaining upon the premises of the boat launch by a person when he knows his entry or remaining upon the premises is unauthorized or under circumstances where he reasonably should know his entry or remaining upon the premises is unauthorized. The New Orleans Municipal Yacht Harbor Corporation shall cause the premises of the public boat launch to be posted in areas of ingress and egress with signs indicating at what hours of the day or night that entry to or remaining upon the premises is prohibited without authorization. Except for special events specifically authorized by the New Orleans Municipal Yacht Harbor Corporation, the premises of the public boat launch shall be closed to the public between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. on the following day. Entry to and use of the premises is permitted for the purpose of actively launching or retrieving a motor or sailing vessel of at least six feet in length. Active launching or retrieving as stated above is authorized 24 hours per day.
- (b) For the purposes of this article, the premises of the public boat launch is the area bounded by Lake Pontchartrain, the Jefferson Parish line and the lake side of Breakwater Drive in the seventh municipal district.
- (c) It shall be unlawful for any person to commit the crime of trespass upon the premises of the public boat launch.
